PLATINUM	\$ 3,600 INCLUDES FULL DUES AND "NACHAS".
GOLD	\$ 2,750 INCLUDES FULL DUES AND "NACHAS".

HOUSEHOLD	\$ 2,050 plus **Building Improvement Fund of \$2,500 payable over 7 years. Either partner age 35 or above or any age with children in grades 1 or above.
SINGLE PARENT	\$ 1,245 plus **Building Improvement Fund of \$1,250 payable over 7 years. One parent family age 35 or above or any age with children in grades 1 or above.
SINGLE	\$ 1,050 plus **Building Improvement Fund of \$1,250 payable over 7 years. Age 35 or above.
YOUNG SINGLES	\$ 285 Under 30 years of age. No children above kindergarten.
	\$ 570 Between 30 and 34 years of age. No children above kindergarten.
YOUNG COUPLES	\$ 565 Under 30 years of age. No children above kindergarten.
	\$ 1,135 Between 30 and 34 years of age. No children above kindergarten.

*****BUILDING IMPROVEMENT FUND APPLICABLE TO NEW MEMBERS, ONLY*****

If a Young Single or Couple is under 35 and has a child in Pre-School or Kindergarten, there will be an additional fee for school, plus the usual activity fee for Kindergarten. Congregants with children in grades 1 and above are no longer considered young Members, regardless of age.

A fee is assessed to families with children in our religious school. The fee is **\$200** per child in grades K - 2 and **\$225** for a child in grades 3 - 7. The maximum for any family is \$450.

A fee of **\$550** will be assessed during the year of a child's Bar or Bat Mitzvah.

The Building Improvement Fund, **APPLICABLE TO NEW MEMBERS, ONLY**, may be paid over 7 years, at \$400 the first year and \$350 for the remaining years (half for singles). If paid in full at the time you join, the fee is discounted to \$2,000 for couples and \$1,000 for singles. Young members receive credit for each year of membership until they are full members.

Requests for variances should be submitted to the Dues & Assessments Committee. Decisions of the Dues & Assessments Committee are final. All information is treated on a confidential basis.
