## FROM THE PRESIDENT

*Rabbi Michael Sacks to Joseph Mendelssohn: And their answer is to have an organ like a church? And have Sabbath on Sunday like a church?*

— “Havdalab,” by Ben Engel



I hope you had the opportunity to see the premiere of Ben Engel’s newest play, “Havdalab,” at The Emanuel Synagogue on Nov 7. The play is about German

Jews in the 1830s-1840s struggling with their identities. It highlights the Mendelssohn family whose bank is known as a “Jewish Bank.” Although the bank has been very successful, it is starting to rupture over its Jewishness. Some of the family members have already converted out of Judaism themselves and/or converted their children. At the same time, the Reformers are breaking away from Orthodoxy — changing liturgy, language and customs of the service (some *mitzvot* as in wearing a *tallit*). As history relates, this was the beginning of the Reform Movement and later spawned the Conservative movement.

The Emanuel Synagogue is a Conservative synagogue. We try to conserve that which is important to us from Orthodoxy. We dress differently, we do use an organ, but we have retained our use of the Hebrew language (mostly) and we have never considered changing the day for our Shabbat. Times have changed, and the pandemic has forced us out of our comfort zones and traditions. We Zoom and Livestream our services. I am concerned this technology has become a way of life for some of us. How nice to stay in your PJs and enjoy your Shabbat breakfast at home while some distant voice *davens*. At the same time, we seem to be reaching more people than previously when you add our virtual congregation to those in the Sanctuary. Our daily afternoon/evening minyan is stronger than ever on Zoom. Congregants, who, for reasons of health or otherwise tell

us how important the Zoom minyan is to them. We have not missed one minyan since the pandemic began. We will not withdraw this option. However, we are now back in the Sanctuary for most of our services. We practice safe habits such as masking and distancing. We enjoy each other’s company at lovingly prepared kiddush luncheons. No one has become ill after attending an Emanuel service in our Sanctuary.

Come, rediscover your Sanctuary and enjoy the peace it brings to us. Meet our new and amazing Hazzan, Daniella Risman. See old friends; make new ones. We have not changed much, just a little weary with the passage of pandemic time. We have had some incredible b’nai mitzvah celebrations that have held great meaning for all.

The staged reading of “Havdalab” was a triumph. It does not provide solutions for these age old problems among our people but it does give us a framework for thinking about these issues. Kudos to the actors who dedicated time and energy, the tireless director (Adrian Durlister), the crew (lighting, sound and costumes), and the box office staff and ushers. It really does take a village to pull this off. Thanks to Marsha Wolfberg for helping to bring it all together and to my co-producer Alan Parker for his steady hand. Finally, of course, *kippahs* off to our resident playwright Ben Engel for putting the words in our mouths and amazing us play after play.

Thanks to all who showed up and to all who supported the play financially. We do this for you. Lastly — come back to The Emanuel! You might just find that something you have been missing during the last 20 months. We are here awaiting you.

## ADULT EDUCATION NEWS



November and December were busy months for the Emanuel Adult Education Committee. Prof. Samuel Kassow spoke about his book *Who Will Write our History?*, telling the story about Emanuel Ringelblum and his cohorts who buried documents detailing the experiences of the inhabitants of the Warsaw ghetto from 1940-1943. Tour guide Mike Hollander led a virtual tour of Jewish sites of St. Petersburg and Moscow. The Braid, a theatrical group, explored the experiences of Jews of color through song and dramatic readings. Rabbi Small and Cantor Risman led us in a virtual lighting of the Chanukah candles, followed by a talk by Professor Avi Patt about the work of the Dodd Center for Human Rights at the University of Connecticut. On a lighter note, Rabbi Elyse Wechterman shared the history of American superheroes and their connection to Jewish folklore and history.

Rabbi Small led thought-provoking discussions about current events and Rebecca Frankel's book, *Into the Forest*, during the Natalie Ziplow study group.

### COMING UP:

• **Wednesdays, Jan. 12-March 2, 11 a.m.:** Join Connie Smilowitz for an eight-week Yiddish group on Zoom. Connie will read the original story "Fun Lublin biz Nyu York" (From *Lublin Until New York*, The Journal of Rivka Zilberg" by Kadya Molodvsky in Yiddish, while translating into English. We will discuss our reactions to this young woman who speaks to us in a very personal way about her experiences as she arrives and adjusts to life here in the U.S., as her family and friends back in Poland are in the midst of the turmoil happening in Europe during the Second World War. This will be an informal group. All are welcome regardless of their knowledge of Yiddish.



• **Sunday, Jan. 9, 1 p.m.:** "A Virtual Tour of Jewish Rome" with Sara Pavoncello. Participants will learn about the history of the Jewish Community of Rome, the oldest in Europe, from its beginning in 161 BCE to modern times. Using pictures, maps and videos, Sara will speak about the bond between Jerusalem and the Colosseum, about the Ghetto that started in 1555 and ended just in 1870. We will learn about typical Jewish Roman traditions such as delicious kosher recipes, the Giudaico Romanesco (their unique language) and the origin of some of the typical Jewish Roman last names.

• **Tuesday, Feb. 1, 8:30 p.m.:** **Jews in American Theater with Entertainment Historian John Kendrick.** Learn about how Jews came to play such a vital role in every aspect of the American Theater, reshaping it during the last 150 years.

• **Wednesday, Feb. 2, 7:30 p.m.:** **The Galilee Culinary Institute by JNF.** Learn about Jewish National Fund's new and innovative culinary institute in Israel's Upper Eastern Galilee with Sheryl Buchholtz, Chair of the Galilee Culinary Institute by JNF-USA. The GCI is part of JNF's strategic initiatives to strengthen and improve the quality of life in the region, through economic development, employment, tourism, housing, and community building. It is located in a region known as the "food basket" of Israel and also is a wonderful mix of cultural, historical, and natural wonders.



• **Sunday, Feb. 6, 1:00 p.m.:** "The Golden Age of Jewish Life in Sepharad/Spain — Guide for the Perplexed." For centuries, the Jewish community of Spain was one the world's most significant. Its creative achievements in the arts, sciences, literature, medicine, diplomacy, etc. were unprecedented for a Diaspora community, largely because of the interaction and integration of the Jewish community in Muslim Spain. All this ended during the same year that Columbus set sail to discover America. We will visit some of the more important Jewish centers, including Córdoba, birthplace of Maimonides, Granada, home of the beautiful Alhambra Palace, where Ferdinand and Isabel issued their expulsion order, as well as the beautiful synagogues of Toledo.

• **Thursday, Feb. 10, 8:30 p.m.:** "The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire: Out of Tragedy Comes Social Justice." On the first day of spring in 1911, a terrible fire broke out in Manhattan's Garment District. When it ended, half an hour later, 146 workers, mostly young



## USING YOUR IRA FOR CHARITABLE GIVING
