FROM THE RABBI

YISHAR KOACH, MEL! PRAISE FOR THE PURPOSE-DRIVEN PRESIDENT



Before Mel Simon became President of The Emanuel, it was clear he intended to take what Dr. Abraham Joshua Heschel calls “a leap of action” (*God in Search of Man*). A stalwart supporter and trusted advisor to Emanuel Presidents Dr. Sheila Silverman and Elysa Graber-Lipperman, Mel investigated the structure and assumptions of synagogue funding and headed a Strategic Committee to explore the evolving clergy needs of our Emanuel Family. As President, Mel displayed his extraordinary ability to focus on the “big picture” while paying close attention to key details. Before the full Board of Trustees or one-on-one, Mel’s meetings serve a specific purpose, follow a coherent agenda and always identify next actions.

Mel leads by example. He takes on tasks large and small and encourages commitment and accountability from other lay leaders and professional staff. At the same time, Mel reflects upon and articulates the ultimate purposes of







FROM THE PRESIDENT — INFLECTION POINT: A MOMENT WHEN SIGNIFICANT CHANGE OCCURS



Please allow me to introduce myself. I am the 43rd President of The Emanuel Synagogue. I have big shoes to fill, and I ask for your help in doing so.

JEWISH ROOTS

Do you recognize the Inflection Points in your lives? I trace my Jewish journey to several moments in time. I remember being enrolled in Hebrew School at age ten. We were encouraged to attend Saturday morning services. Few ten-year-olds do so willingly, and my parents didn't force it. They didn't have to. As an incentive, my Hebrew School gave us little stamp books similar to the S&H Green stamp books. Many of you may recall saving S&H stamps and redeeming them for merchandise. We received stamps with depictions of the *parasha* for each week and each holiday service we attended. Although there was nothing of a material nature the filled stamps book could get you, I coveted those stamps and filled my books for three years. The result — I loved going to synagogue and was well prepared for my Bar Mitzvah.

BAR MITZVAH

Our Mom (I am one of three sons), passed away five months before my Bar Mitzvah, an event which could have derailed all hopes and dreams of success. I turned away from Judaism following my Bar Mitzvah. My Hebrew name died with my mother; no one else knew it. I was called to the Torah by a name given me by Rabbi Jacob Chinitz, of blessed memory — *Yeshayahu Ze'ev ben Gershon v' Chaya*, the same name by which I am called to the Torah today.

RECONNECTING TO JUDAISM

I met my future wife, Pam, in law school. Her parents had a warm, comfortable Jewish home. We married and established our home

a short distance from The Emanuel Synagogue. Fire burned the Emanuel Synagogue in 1983, and we became members. Four years later our daughter, Elena, was born. Elena attended Hebrew School. Torat Chayim (a component of our religious school) required parents to participate in Sunday morning programming. I heard Rabbi Lazowski tell his story, and I remember thinking, if this man has faith after his journey during the Holocaust, my doubts pale by comparison.

ISRAEL

Pam and I took a congregational trip to Israel with Rabbi Gerald Zelermyer, Heske and Gideon in 1999. My relationship with the Jewish People and the State of Israel was signed, sealed and delivered. I have returned ten times since. Those who have spent time in Israel understand this passion. Coming home from

that trip I pledged to study, learn, participate and contribute to The Emanuel as my West Hartford connection to Israel and Jewishness.

LEADERSHIP

Finally, as I watched my brother Mel in the last two years place Emanuel on his shoulders and help carry it through one of its most challenging episodes in our more than 100 years, I realized he needed my help; I answered his call by agreeing to follow him as President. And so, *Hineni*, Here I Am.

The next time you come into our sanctuary please notice the inscription over our *Bima*: "*You are holy for I, the Lord, am holy.*" There are many reasons why we come to our sacred space. All are valid and important. I believe as we reenter that sacred space we are at an Inflection Point. Others have carried us

work on behalf of our synagogue and keep our mission alive and well.

Mel faced challenging questions during his term:

- What measures shall we take during COVID-19 to protect our members and staff? How can we stay in touch with our members during this fraught and frightening time?
- Why should our members stay connected with and continue to support The Emanuel when access to the physical building is limited?
- Where will we find the financial resources to keep our Emanuel strong?
- Who will we look to for current and future support and leadership of our congregation? Who will step up to our Board of Trustees and Executive Committee? Who will succeed me as President?
- How will we learn, strategize and build for our future?

For each of these questions, Mel studied, thought, discussed, engaged others and acted. With his strong guidance and unswerving determination, The Emanuel emerges from one of the most challenging periods in any congregation's life, and we not only survive but we thrive.

Mel kept another key question before him throughout his term: How can I best work together with our Rabbi to serve the needs of our congregation and how can I support the Rabbi in serving our people in a most trying period? Week after week Mel made sure we were in sync and gave regular, generous support at the most challenging times.

B'YADEYNU NEWS

Thank you to all who donated to the Passover Fund this year. We had an amazing response! The total was \$4,087. The following organizations were the recipients of these funds: Foodshare, the food distribution agency for the Greater Hartford area; the Anja Rosenberg K kosher Food Pantry of Jewish Family Services; Leket Israel, the food collection and distribution agency in Israel; and CIRC (Connecticut Immigrant and Refugee Services Coalition), a non-profit organization promoting the rights of immigrants and refugees in Connecticut.

In addition, a \$500 contribution was made from B'Yadefnu's discretionary fund to United Hatzalah of Israel (www.israelrescue.org). Their mission is to provide rapid emergency medical care to all people in Israel regardless of race, religion or national origin. There are 6,000 volunteers around the country available 24 hours



a day, 7 days a week. Traveling on specially equipped motorcycle ambulances, volunteer medics can arrive on scene within three minutes or less, stabilizing a patient while waiting for an ambulance. The volunteer team is diverse, consisting of Jews and Arabs, religious and secular Jews, Druze, Bedouins and Christians.

We went on a virtual tour of the Tenement Museum, learned about the Beatles, the influence of Jewish women in America, the musical contributions of the late Debbie Friedman, the intricacies of Israel's West Bank, how our Bible came to be, and explored the history of the Jewish deli. Rabbi Small led the Natalie Ziplow Study Group with both study of traditional texts and discussions of contemporary current events.
