INSTRUCTIONS FOR Hagbahat Hatorah (Raising the Torah)

- When instructed to do so, begin by rolling the Torah scroll open, so that three columns of text are showing.
- Next, lift and slide the handles toward you, so that approximately 1/3 of each side of the scroll is overhanging the edge of the reading desk.
- Raise the scroll to a vertical position by (gently) pressing down on the handles. The edge of the desk will act as a fulcrum, making it easier to stand the Torah up straight.
- 4. Immediately raise the Torah while holding it open. As you are led to a seat on the pulpit, turn the Torah from side to side so the congregation may view the columns of text you are displaying. The attendants will walk with you to ensure that you don't drop the Torah, or stumble on the way.
- Once you are seated, the person honored with G'lilat Hatorah (dressing the Torah) will roll the two scrolls together, belt them, and cover them with the mantle.
