Ten Commandments of Inclusion

Inclusion and Access at The Emanuel Synagogue:

"My house shall be a house of worship for all people" (Isaiah 7:2)

We will create a supportive and accepting environment at The Emanuel Synagogue to fully include all members in our synagogue.

In keeping with this commitment, we offer:

- Priority handicapped parking spaces in our main parking lot
- Curb cuts and ramps for wheelchairs, walkers and strollers in the front entrance and level access in our back entrance
- Powered doors at front and back entrances
- Priority seating space in the Main Sanctuary for people with wheelchairs, walkers or strollers
- Level access in our main lobbies, corridors, Sanctuary, Social Halls and patios
- A permanent ramp adjacent to the Main Sanctuary *bimah (stage)* allowing access for wheelchairs and walkers
- Wheelchair-accessible restrooms on the main level
- Changing tables in women's and men's restrooms
- State-of-the-art sound system in the main sanctuary and auditoriums
- Headsets for the hearing impaired
- Large print prayer books available in the Main Sanctuary and Chapel
- Upgraded lighting
- Open seating to allows congregants to find the best spot for participation and engagement
