BABYSITTING

As a courtesy service to our members and guests, The Emanuel Synagogue offers babysitting for children ages 1-5 years old, with the following guidelines:



- Once a child is dropped off, he/she must remain in the babysitting room until a designated adult comes to pick up him/her.



- For the safety of all, children older than age 5 are not permitted to wander in and out of the babysitting room, and must remain in services (Family or Regular) or be supervised by an adult.
