NEW BUSINESS

Torah Restoration Project Sheila Silverman

We have passed the halfway point to our fundraising goal, and 50% of the monies have come from BOT members

Restroom Renovation Hilda Slivka

Tried to get three estimates for working on the renovation of the women's pink restroom adjacent to Silverman Auditorium, but only heard back from one contractor, who we had used successfully for the last bathroom renovations. In order to get an updated bid for the work, it is necessary to drill a hole in the ceiling near to sinks to look into the space to see if a section of wall is able to be taken down. We currently have \$11,000 in the Restroom Renovation Fund, and are hoping to also use the Gift Card monies of \$72,000 for the project.

MOTION: (made by Hilda Slivka/seconded by Andrea Goldenberg) That we allocate \$2200 from the Bathroom Renovation Fund, for an exploratory survey to investigate functional structures and building code compliances in the Women's east restroom. This involves making a hole in the ceiling and covering it temporarily as well as further involvement with the previous architect.

Livestream Service Call Ken Simon

The upgrade to the livestream and zoom streaming services has been completed and all is working well. We are now able to zoom from the chapel, and plan to do so starting March 1.

Gate Automation Tom Mastronarde

Looking to install electronic locks on outdoor gates with the fencing to permit flexible access control. It will give us the option to lock the gates as well as limit access when we deem it necessary. The current master controller cannot do everything we need it to do. The BOT previously approved a \$37,000 expenditure from the Security Fund; more monies are needed.

MOTION: (made by Rick Lasker/seconded by Jeremy Rubock) Move that the BOT allocate an additional \$12,000 from the Emanuel Security Fund to update the Building Security System to enable flexible access control for two gates

motion passes unanimously

We have been working on five security projects over the last eighteen months, and four have been completed. We still have to install the chapel windows anti fragmentation protection. We are also working on a grant application from the State of CT for up to \$50,000 for our security projects.
