GRANT APPLICATIONS - House Committee continues to work with Tom, Joyce and Kobi and the Security Committee to review the Security Report from SCN (Secure Community Network).

The object is to develop recommendations for increasing our security both inside and outside our building, for our children, congregants, guests and staff, and to prepare for the 2022 FEMA Security Grant application. (The funding is presently being held up in Congress, but is expected to be released soon. At that time, the application and approval process will be compressed and expedited, according to SCN)

SECURITY IMPROVEMENTS FEMA 2021 GRANT:

We have issued the contract for improving the Exterior Lighting. The Emergency Notification System will be awarded as soon as final scope of work is determined.

The On-Site Training has begun by SCN.

The quarterly planning and progress report to FEMA for October, November, and December has been submitted by Joyce, Kobi and myself.

PROJECTS
