The membership committee has been meeting on a monthly basis.

- 1. We have about 10 families that are prospective members.
- 2. Since 7/1/2022 -1/31/2024: we have had 28 resignations and 61 new member families. Of those 61 families, 8 families are from diverse backgrounds.
