Kobi, Rabbi Small and Ken Simon went to Florida to meet with our Emanuel members. It was a great experience seeing our members in their winter location.

Approval Of Minutes, February 21, 2023 Minutes

Motion made and approved unanimously.

FEMA Grants and Generator Project: Howard Smith

Our third FEMA application, which first goes to the state, must be in by end of April. We have had FEMA grants for last 2 years. We are now completing those projects. We advance money for projects and FEMA reimburses us after completion.

Generators can be funded. John Coangelo endorses acquisition of generator to secure our security systems.

We now have > \$150,000 in security funds and we will get money back from FEMA 1 and 2, so there should be enough money to use for generator project. The money for generator will be needed 1 year from now, so with money coming back, there should be adequate money. For FEMA 1 we have done the lighting for \$26,000 and we have an intercom system pending which will cost \$24,000. After completion we will get reimbursed, probably in the fall.

Motion by Reesa Olins and seconded by Jeff Cohen: The Emanuel Synagogue apply to NSGP/FEMA for funding of the design and complete installation of a backup/emergency generator for our building at 160 Mohegan Drive, West Hartford, and if approved by NSGP/FEMA, the Synagogue agrees to fund the installation until completion, final approval, and reimbursement by FEMA, at a maximum amount of \$150,000 or as allowed by NSGP/FEMA

Motion passes unanimously.

Rabbi's Report

The Rabbi sent out his report of his activities to the board. It is included at end of minutes. The Rabbi said 160 people have donated in memory of his mother, Sara Small. He thanks our congregation for our support. This raised almost \$9000 in contributions to The Emanuel

Conflict of Interest Policy- Lou Blumenfeld and Robert Teitelman

There has not been a review by board members of this policy, so the board is in violation of its obligation. Document is an attempt to show we are not benefitting members monetarily. Every member is supposed to sign on to this policy. The committee started its review 2 years ago and the final revision is presented tonight.

Recent Projects I am supporting/supported:

Torah Renewal Project: Coach Lay leaders on rolling Torah Scrolls, Work with Committee on path forward for evaluating Torah Scrolls and determining their future disposition. Start to lay groundwork for education in the Fall

Immigrant Shabbat: Work with lay chairs of Byadeynu, Janet Wallans and Ken Malley and with Hilda Slivka, and with Rev.Susan Gibson of First Church of Farmington to plan order of the Shabbat Service, speakers and on-bimah "Dialogue" about the experience of helping refugee families resettle in CT and insights we have gained.
