FROM THE PRESIDENT

BRUCHIM HABAIM — ALL ARE WELCOME!

We really mean it! We have a large building with space to share. The Children's Museum School and The Children's Museum could no longer stay at their most recent address, a place many of us have loved and enjoyed. We were in a position to offer a temporary home as the Museum and school plan their future location within three to five years. The first lease was negotiated by Emanuel Executive Director Kobi Benita and realtor Lisa Sadinsky, drafted by Atty. Mitchell Jaffe and signed by me. As we already were permitted to house a nursery school (the former Lollipop Tree), the Children's Museum School was able to begin classes on time this semester. On Aug. 8, the West Hartford Town Planning and Zoning Committee heard the application to bring approximately 40 percent of the exhibits and the administrative offices of The Children's Museum to our campus. We received unanimous approval by the Town, with members of the board expressing loving memories of both organizations. Rabbi Small spoke about our value of saving animals as exemplified in the biblical story of Noah's Ark. Upon this approval, we signed a second lease. This was a win for the Town of West Hartford, the Museum, and The Emanuel.

You will notice new signage on our property. The Museum and School address is 180 Mohegan Drive. They will share our vast parking lot and ingress and egress. More important, I hope you will have a chance to again enjoy the sounds of the nursery school children in the playground near our religious school. These are some of the sweetest sounds you will ever hear. Please stop by and visit the Museum when you are here. Museum hours are respectful of our holiday and Shabbat services.



Many of you may remember the Gengras Planetarium which was at the Trout Brook address of the museum. The Laser Light shows were always a great experience. I was lucky to be an invited guest to the last show. The Laser Light accompaniment to The Dark Side Of The Moon was out of this world! It is sad to say farewell to the planetarium; it closed a few weeks ago and will ultimately be leveled to the ground to accommodate luxury apartments. Conny the Whale will be relocated nearby on Trout Brook Drive. Fortunately, we have the museum on our premises. Let us welcome the people who work at the museum and nursery school and their visitors with a warm Emanuel *bruchim habaim* — welcome!

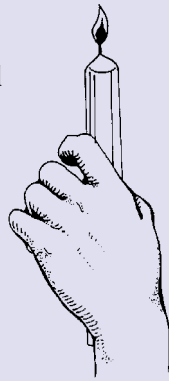

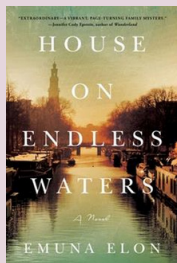
LISA'S JEWISH BOOKS CORNER

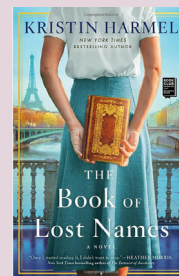
Woman on Fire, by Lisa Barr
