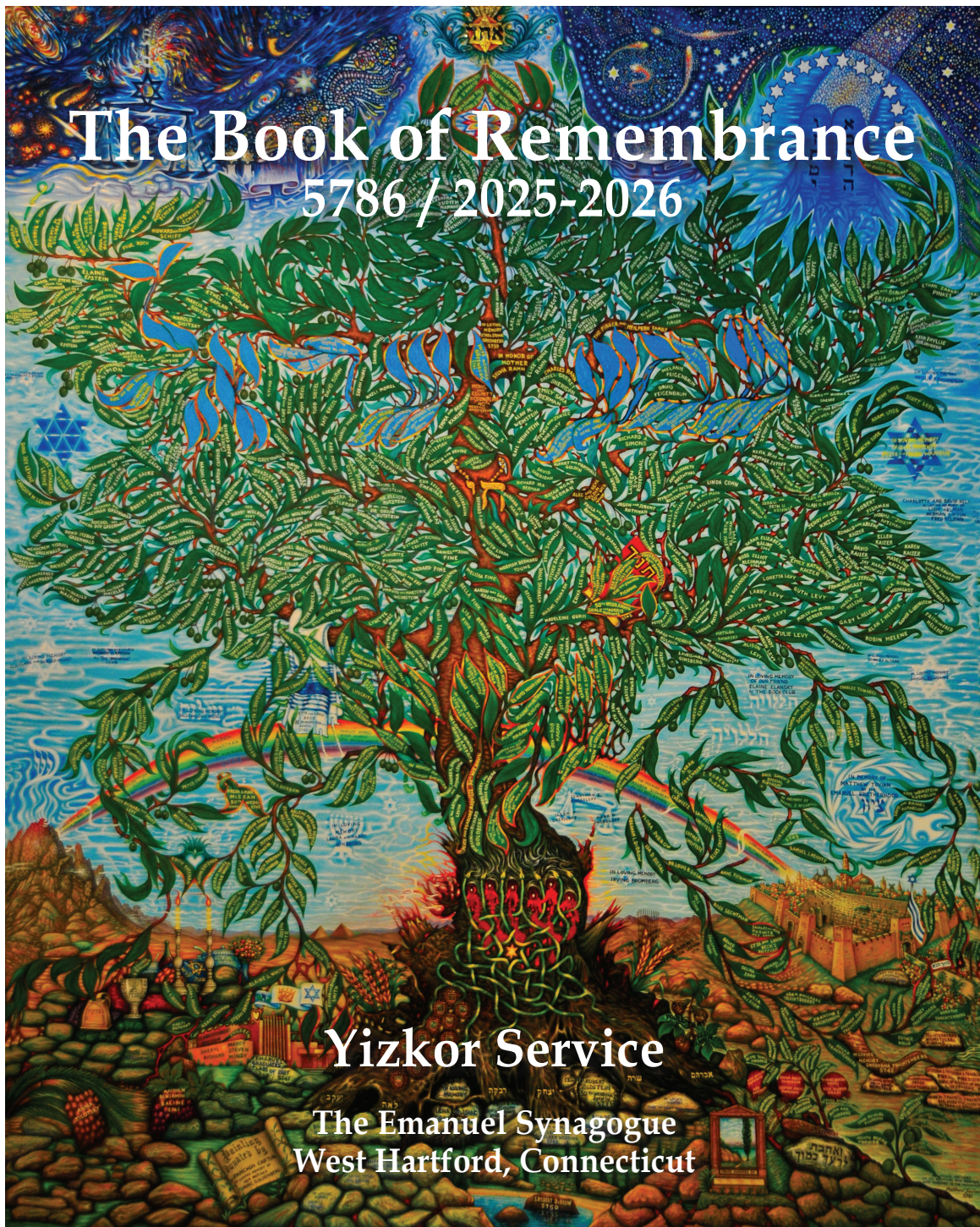

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Yizkor for Victims of Oct. 7, 2023



Two years since the evil onslaught of October 7, war continues to burn, lives continue to be lost, hostages suffer in captivity and evildoers remain at large. The Simchat Torah attacks join a set of calamities mourned by our people for all generations to come. The Yizkor service was created 800 years ago, in the aftermath of slaughter, as Jewish communities in the Rhine Valley mourned their loved ones murdered in pogroms and Crusader attacks that bear hideous resemblance to the assault we witnessed in Israel on Simchat Torah two years ago. The Yizkor service confers honor and remembrance on those who died. We who survive mourn the dead, affirm courage, and resolve in the face of hatred and brutality. We ask that their souls be gathered "*bitzror ha-chayim*," the "Bundle of Life," a "profound concept of an eternal, timeless community in which the living and the dead are alike embraced." As we, the living, rise to recite Yizkor, on our holiest days let us stand with our dead and remember them that they may survive in our hearts. We enfold their souls in our love and seek comfort in this hour of communion with them. We pray for the return of all our hostages. May the Holy One grant us the strength and courage to fight evil, live with integrity and uphold the highest values of our people, embodied in the lives of our loved ones whom we remember, now and forever.

Yizkor: Making the Connection

Yizkor is a request, directed to the Holy One, to remember our loved ones. In the act of asking G-d to remember, we ourselves perform a powerful act of loving memory. Why ask the One who remembers everything to remember? Does G-d need a reminder? Why not simply say, “I remember”? By using this form, we emphasize that the act of loving memory is on behalf of our beloved. While it gives us comfort, we say their names and ask G-d to remember them for their benefit and for their honor.

Yizkor is our way of staying connected with our departed. Jewish culture values improvisation and constant invention; we also find great meaning performing the same action — with love and purpose — again and again. Yizkor is one of these important repeated actions. Our loved ones’ names are on our lips — Yom Tov after Yom Tov, year after year — as long as we have the breath within us to utter their names. When we keep faith with them in this way, we accord our dead an earthly immortality. They live on in our actions as well as in our hearts and minds.

One important way to honor the memory of our loved ones is to give a contribution in their memory. This gift is a true act of loving-kindness; we keep alive our loved one’s name through performance of this sacred and important task. This is what our Sages meant when they taught, *Tzedakah tatzil mimavet*, “Charitable giving saves from death.” Giving in memory of our dead saves them from oblivion by affirming their memory among the living through good deeds.

These generous acts to and for our dead elevate us and refine our hearts. When we honor and love the people who touched our lives, we honor and love the Creator of us all.

The Yizkor book is a time-honored Jewish practice. We hope that this book brings comfort to those who mourn and honor our departed, whom we remember with love.

A Yizkor Reflection: What Does It All Mean?

On the High Holy Days we confront the temporary, contingent quality of life. We ask ourselves, “What will remain after me when I die?” “What does it all mean” In the Amidah of Yom Kippur, we ask:

“Mah anachnu? Mah Chayeyinu? Mah Chasdeinu? Mah Tzidkeinu? Mah Yisheinu? Mah Kocheinu? Mah Gvuroteinu?”

What are we? What is our life? What is our goodness? What is our righteousness? What is our achievement? What is our power? What are our victories?

The litany of “Mah....Mah....Mah....” hits us like a series of body blows. Unrelenting, the words bludgeon out of us any residual pridefulness that might stand in the way of sincere repentance.

Illusions of glory ring hollow, pretense and status shatter before us:

Heroes count as nothing in your presence, famous people are as if they never existed, the wise seem ignorant, and clever ones as if they lack reason....all is vanity.

How depressing! If so, why don't we just give up? Self-improvement is exhausting. If all life is futile and then you die, why bother?

Yet...the message of this prayer can be read differently. This liturgical “Bonfire of the Vanities” burns away the unimportant and reveals the enduring virtues, the actions and attributes that not only mean something in this life, they mean everything,

Power? Meh. Celebrity? Yawn. Intellectual Status? Big deal. Cleverness? So what?

The typical measures of accomplishment, money fame, status are of no use when the final bell rings.

What then, will endure? Let's go back to the original series of questions:

What are we? What is our life? What are we really? Not the PR version but emes, the essential impact of a human being on this earth.

Chayeyinu: Our life is the sum of our deeds, the joys and sorrow of our existence while we live.

Chasdeinu: Our goodness or kindness. Acts of goodness and kindness to people and animals matter.

Tzidkeinu: Our righteousness, fairness, doing what is right. Not to be confused with self-righteousness.

When we remain open to all life, with its blessings and sorrows, then we have lived fully. When we live in such a way that our acts of kindness and justice are remembered by others, then our life is of consequence. Fame and glory mean little. But acts of goodness and justice are everlasting. The kindness we return to our dead is that we highlight these good deeds and loving ways and let the rest recede into the shadows. We choose what to hold on to and what to release. Remembering our dead in this way becomes an ultimate act of kindness. In this way, we perpetuate a living chain of caring, of humanity and love that are rich and full measure to life; to theirs and to ours, and to those who will come after us.

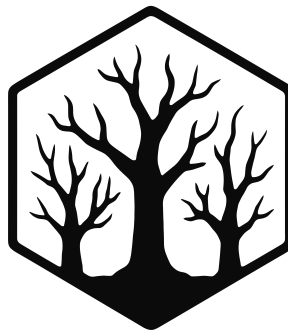
Collective Memory

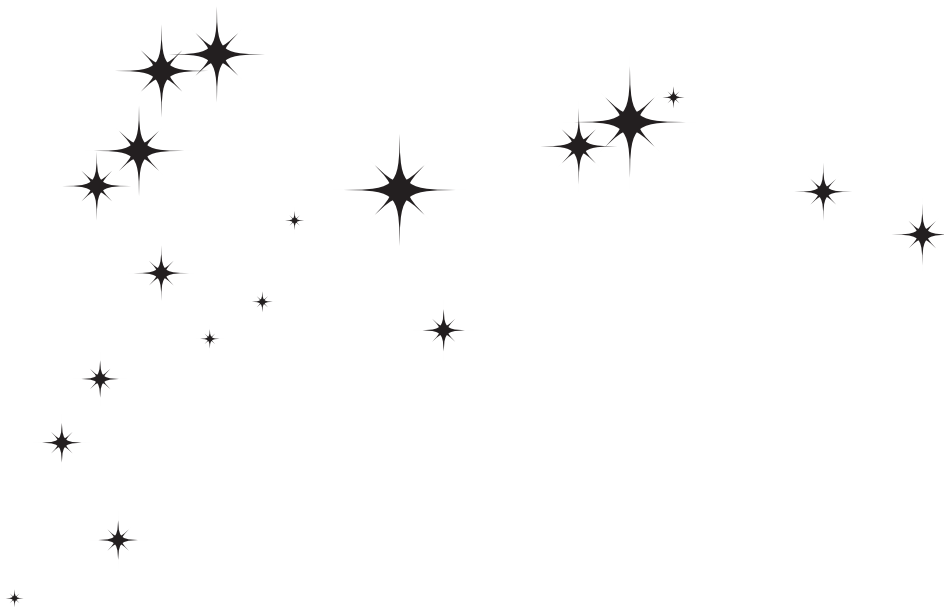
“Upon your ramparts, City of David, I have set guards.”
